### **BEE DISEASE INSURANCE (BDI)**

Up to 3 colonies are included in the Registered and Junior member subscriptions and are Gift Aidable.

When insuring, potential increase must be taken into consideration, this includes nuclei and swarms.

If the number of colonies managed exceeds the number of colonies for which the premium has been paid, no cover will apply under the BDI policy.

BDI cover only becomes operative after 3 months following receipt of your subscription.

## Conditions of donating with Gift Aid.
